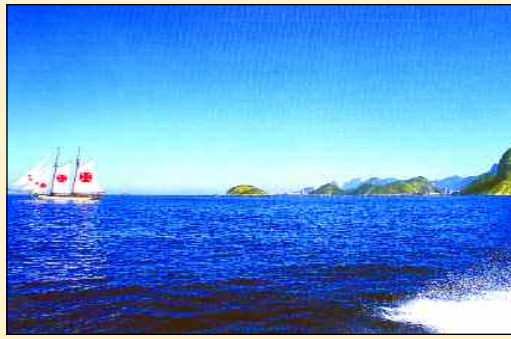

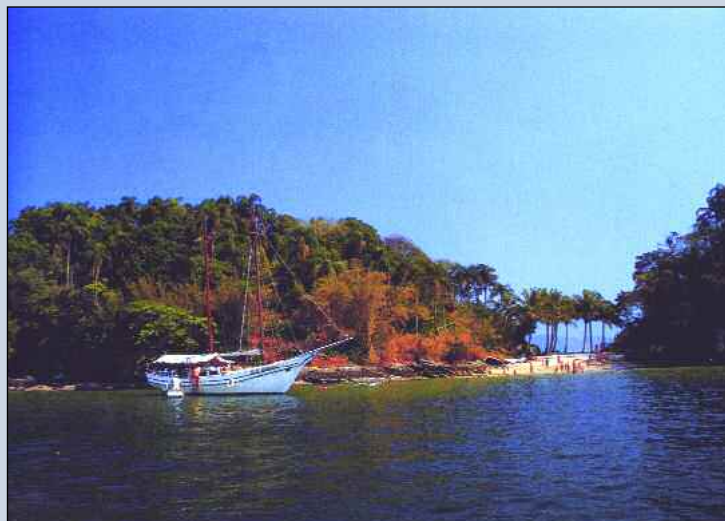

Weather in Rio

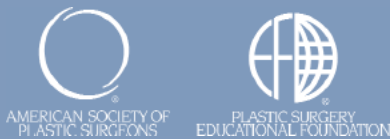

✈ Travel Tips

Airports - Rio de Janeiro has two airports. Galeão Antonio Carlos Jobim International Airport (GIG) is about 20 minutes from the Sofitel. Most major airlines fly into this airport.

The smaller airport, Santos Dumont (SDU), is more centrally located; however, you're only likely to use this airport if you're connecting through São Paulo.

Visas - Residents of the following countries do not need a Brazilian Visa. This list may change at any time. Please contact your nearest Brazilian Consulate before making any travel arrangements.

Countries exempt from Brazilian Tourist Visa requirements: Andorra, Argentina, Austria, Bahamas, Barbados, Belgium, Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Denmark, Ecuador, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Morocco, Monaco, Namibia, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea, San Marino, South Africa, Spain, Suriname, Sweden, Switzerland, Thailand, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkey, United Kingdom, Uruguay, Vatican and Venezuela.

Passports - All visitors require passports that are valid for at least the period of intended stay in Brazil. Sufficient funds to cover their stay in Brazil, as well as a return or onward ticket and documentation required for further travel is also necessary for all travellers.

Taxis - Taxis are available outside the terminal; visitors are advised to buy prepaid taxi vouchers at the Rio Tourism Authority desk; they are usually a little more expensive but will give you peace of mind.

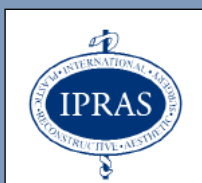
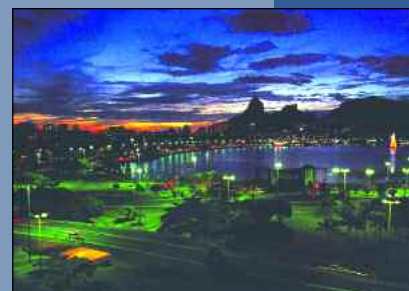
